



Battery calibration please do not unplug the power supply

How can I calibrate my battery?

You can calibrate the battery with a single click. In UWP Dragon Center and Creator Center, go to the Tools tab and click on the Battery Calibration icon to open the Window. In MSI Center for Business and Productivity, go to System Diagnosis in the Support tab and click on the Battery Calibration icon to open the Window.

Can I calibrate my laptop battery if state of charge is available?

If State of Charge is available, you CAN calibrate the battery. The BIOS battery calibration utility cannot work with the generic batteries. When you run it, all that it will do is keep the laptop turned on until the battery is drained to zero then turn off the laptop.

How do I adjust battery settings before calibration?

Also you can adjust Battery settings before you do the calibration in order to make sure it can 100% discharge. Hardware and Sound > Power Options > Edit Plan settings > Change advanced power settings. Set Low battery level/Reserve battery level to 0%. runningman date=1439895008 said:

Do I need superuser rights to calibrate the battery?

You will need superuser rights to properly calibrate the battery. We discharge the battery to 1%, then connect the switched on phone to the switched on charger and charge up to 100%. Not turning off

How do I calibrate a battery in MSI center pro?

To calibrate the battery in MSI Center Pro, go to the Battery Optimizer in Optimization, then click on the Battery Calibration icon to open the Window. Before starting the calibration, please connect the adapter and do not remove it until Battery Calibration is done. In MSI Center Pro, go to the Battery Optimizer in Optimization for the battery calibration process.

How do I know if my AC adapter is fully charged?

On reboot Windows will reinstall battery management, reset all variables, and show the battery fully charged. With a generic battery when the BIOS reports that the ac adapter is unplugged, the Microsoft battery management driver knows the battery is discharging so it starts timing it.

Do the following trick ... (1) Open the windows device manager and uninstall the "Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery"; - Right click on "Microsoft ACPI-Compliant ...
