Why is my laptop battery not charging?

Your battery may be fully charged, but the power gauge is giving you a false reading. This can be because of some stored data relating to the former battery. If your laptop battery is not charging to 100% you may need to calibrate your battery. Power down the computer. Unplug the wall adapter. Uninstall the battery.

Why is my laptop battery not charging at 80%?

Calibration needed: If the battery hasn't been calibrated recently, your system may misread the charge percentage, causing the battery to stop charging at 80%. We hope one of the above solutions helped you fix your laptop battery if it's not charging above 80%.

Why is my new battery charging to 100%?

The new battery usually is charging to 100% even though the power gauge software doesn't correctly represent this. Often with new batteries, the operating system is unable to correctly measure the charge in the new battery. Your battery may be fully charged, but the power gauge is giving you a false reading.

To see if Windows can fix the battery not charging problem, you can run the power troubleshooter. 1. In the search type "troubleshoot settings" and then click to open them from the search results. 2. In the 'Troubleshoot' window, select Additional troubleshooters. 3. Scroll down and click on Power.
