Do I need to re-enter my anti-theft car radio security code?

When replacing your car battery, particularly on older cars you may have to enter your anti-theft car radio security code once power is restored. However, many people have lost their original code. This guide explains what you can do to try to avoid having to re-enter the code.

Can a replacement battery be installed without a BEM code?

If a high-quality replacement battery is installed, even without entering a BEM code, there is no safety risk, there is no risk of overcharging of the newly installed replacement battery, there is no increased battery wear, and the vehicle electronics or other components are not damaged.

How do I know if a new battery has been installed?

Do I need to register a new battery?

Depending on the make of car and the functionality of the respective system (open or closed), modern vehicles with Battery Energy Management (BEM) may or may not require or recommend that the new battery be registered.

Does w204/w212/r172 need battery coding in?

The W213/W222/W205/etc platform requires you to do "Teach In" process in the front SAM using a diagnosis tool to tell the charging system the battery has been replaced. Hope that helps.
