How often should you change your car battery?

If you use your car infrequently, avoid letting its battery become drained by on-board computer systems by taking it for a short drive - around the block once or twice will do - to recharge it every week or two. For example, MG suggests only charging between 20 and 80 per cent to extend battery life, and not to let charge drop below 50 per cent 'too often'.
