

# How to use the battery in the computer room

How to use a new laptop's battery?

If you have bought a new laptop, you should take proper measures regarding charging, discharging in order to maximize your laptop's battery life. Here are a few tips and suggestions to properly use a new laptop's battery:

Tip 1: Always Drain Out the Battery Charge Before First use

How to charge a new laptop?

Always charge your new laptop's battery completely and then unplug the AC power charger. Then switch on the laptop and use it, till the complete battery power is exhausted. When the battery power is 0; your laptop will automatically switch off or hibernate. Now plug the AC power back and charge the laptop as usual.

Should I keep my laptop plugged in after removing the battery?

The same for your laptop, if you have removed the battery. The battery works like a UPS (uninterruptible power supply), so you can still use your laptop and turn it off safely. I'd keep it plugged in. Some laptops have a threshold where the AC doesn't charge the battery at all until it drops below a certain point.

Do I need a battery to run a laptop?

@Arjan - Windows default power settings are generally to conserve more power at the expense of performance when running on battery. However, if AC power is connected then the battery is not needed, after all, the PSU can supply enough power to charge the battery AND run the laptop. @Bruce - no more so than any other PC.

How do you save battery on a laptop?

Choose the "Power saver" mode and tweak the settings for brightness, dim the display, turning it off and putting the computer to sleep. This will ensure that minimum resources are used when the computer is running on battery. How do you take care of your laptop's battery ?

How should a laptop battery be charged?

The battery should be kept around room temperature and charging should be performed during off-peak hours whenever possible. The laptop battery should be kept at a medium charge level (around 40%) if it will not be used for a significant period of time.

To start using a computer, make sure it's plugged into a power source and turned on. Once the computer is on, follow the prompts on the screen to make a user account, ...

Plug the computer to the A/C power to perform a full charge non-stop until its maximum capacity (100%). You may use the computer normally within this period.
