Why does my battery make a noise when charging?

There are going to be some sort of sine with distortion and noise coming from your wall and while it's charging the chargers doing what it's supposed to do, but when your battery is fully charged, the filtering noise occasionally get loud on certain chargers.

How do I set a sound when a battery is charged?

Why does my laptop not make a sound when charging?

No sound comes when the laptop is charging below 100%. What could be the reason? It could be the battery, the charger, or the power regulation subsystem in the laptop itself. If you have another battery, use that instead. If you have another charger, try that instead.

What does a new battery sound like?

When trying to start a Honda Civic with a new battery, it sounds the same as it did with the old battery, essentially like a dead battery (minus the clicking sound). It almost sounds like the battery is unable to provide enough power to overcome some compression or resistance.
