

# Lead-acid batteries are prohibited from export

Can I export lead acid batteries from England?

Where POPs will be destroyed, you may include recovery of lead or recycling of plastic that does not contain POPs. The combination of hazardous waste and POPs severely restricts both destination countries and allowed waste management options. You must notify the export of lead acid batteries from England to destinations outside the UK.

What happens if you export a lead-acid battery for reclamation?

For exporters of spent lead-acid batteries (SLABs) for reclamation, this means that export shipments of SLABs will be prohibited after the effective date unless the exporter has submitted a notification and obtained consent from EPA and the receiving country.

Can I treat or export a battery?

Please note that you cannot treat or export automotive or industrial batteries without approval being granted. You must follow extra rules if you manage waste batteries, including collection, treatment, recycling and export. These are in addition to your duty of care and hazardous waste regulation requirements.

Can I repack a lead acid battery?

You may only temporarily store or repack waste lead acid batteries containing POPs before: You must also sort lead acid batteries with polypropylene cases, that should not contain POPs, from those with other cases. You must also hold an environmental permit or exemption that allows this activity.

Do you need an abto to export a battery?

The rules are different for waste portable, industrial and automotive batteries. You must be an Approved Battery Treatment Operator (ABTO) if you: You must be an Approved Battery Exporter (ABE) if you: Evidence notes are proof of treatment, recycling or export of portable waste batteries by an ABTO or ABE.

Does a waste lead acid battery contain Pops?

This guidance applies to waste automotive, industrial and portable lead acid batteries. It does not apply to other types of waste battery. The plastic cases of waste lead acid batteries may contain persistent organic pollutants (POPs). You can identify if a waste lead acid battery may contain POPs by checking: Where the battery case is made of :
