

Lithium battery negative electrode

What happens if a lithium-deficient battery is a negative electrode?

Therefore, it is reasonable to speculate that in the lithium-deficient scenario, the rapid consumption of active lithium metal in the negative electrode leads to the delithiation of Li_2O to supplement lithium ions and maintain battery cycling [6].

What is a lithium metal negative electrode?

This results in a lithium metal negative electrode, used in both laboratory or industry scenarios, typically with a thickness of several tens to even hundreds of micrometers, which not only leads to the wastage of this costly metal resource but also significantly compromises the energy density of SSLMBs [10].

Why do lithium ions flow from a negative electrode to a positive electrode?

Since lithium is more weakly bonded in the negative than in the positive electrode, lithium ions flow from the negative to the positive electrode, via the electrolyte (most commonly LiPF_6 in an organic, carbonate-based solvent [20]).

What is the electrochemical reaction at the negative electrode in Li-ion batteries?

The electrochemical reaction at the negative electrode in Li-ion batteries is represented by $x \text{Li}^+ + 6 \text{C} + x \text{e}^- \rightarrow \text{Li}_x \text{C}_6$. The Li^+ -ions in the electrolyte enter between the layer planes of graphite during charge (intercalation). The distance between the graphite layer planes expands by about 10% to accommodate the Li^+ -ions.

What are the recent trends in electrode materials for Li-ion batteries?

This mini-review discusses the recent trends in electrode materials for Li-ion batteries. Elemental doping and coatings have modified many of the commonly used electrode materials, which are used either as anode or cathode materials. This has led to the high diffusivity of Li ions, ionic mobility and conductivity apart from specific capacity.
