What can a wireless charger charge?

Read more about our editorial standards. A wireless charger can be used to charge any electronic device with Qi (pronounced "chee") capabilities, including all current iPhones, most Android phones, and many wireless earbuds, smart watches, fitness trackers, and other wearables.

Will a Qi-enabled Charger work on my Android phone?

Most Android phones that support wireless charging can be juiced up with Qi-enabled chargers, even if they have proprietary charging profiles for wireless charging. You might not reach the top wireless charging speed, but they'll definitely work.

Can you use a wireless charger with a smartphone?

Providing they support the same wireless charging standard (e.g. Qi), you can use any wireless charger with your smartphone. They don't need to be made by the same manufacturer--you can use a Samsung wireless charger with an iPhone, for example.

Does a wireless charger come with everything I need to charge?

It delivers up to 15W of charging power and uses magnetic alignment to improve charging speed and offer universal compatibility with Qi2 devices (including the iPhone 15 series and up) and any future products designed with Qi2 compatibility. Do wireless chargers come with everything I need to charge? Yes and no.

How do you charge a phone without a battery?

If you have plenty of time to spare, like when you charge overnight, consider plugging your phone into the wall rather than relying on wireless tech. Moreover, try using a 10W or 18W fast charging brick as these don't generate nearly as much heat. You don't always need 65W or 150W charging, after all.

Can You charge a phone with a cable?

If you choose to use it with a cable, Samsung, Google, and Apple phones can charge at an 18W fast charging speed. The InfinaCore P3 Pandora Portable Power Bank is a genius charging solution. This versatile 18W PD wall charger sports a rubber pad and wireless charging coil on the side to charge your phone wirelessly.
