Did Russia attack Ukraine's energy infrastructure?

Russia has launched a huge attack on Ukraine's energy infrastructure, which authorities said was the 12th large-scale attack on energy facilities this year. Ninety-three missiles and more than 200 drones were used - but 81 of the missiles were shot down, according to Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky.

Is Russia targeting Ukraine's energy facilities?

The facility has been repeatedly targeted by Russian airstrikes. Mauricio Lima for The New York Times Russia launched a missile attackon Ukraine's energy infrastructure early Friday,in an assault that President Volodymyr Zelensky described as "one of the largest strikes" on his country's power facilities.

How has Russia impacted Ukraine's energy system?

For the second consecutive winter, Russia has increased military attackson Ukraine's energy system, significantly undermining the security of the country's power supply.

Is the energy sector under a massive attack in Ukraine?

"The enemy continues its terror. Once again, the energy sector across Ukraine is under massive attack," Ukrainian energy minister German Halushchenko said on his official Facebook page. The extent of the damage had yet to be clarified, he said, while urging people to remain in shelters.

What happened to Ukraine's energy infrastructure in 2022?

In October 2022,Ukraine's energy minister said that about 30% of Ukraine's energy infrastructure appeared to have been attacked in a single day, and during the following seven months, Russia used missiles and drones to target energy facilities across the country, leaving no thermal or hydro power plant untouched.
