

# Use waste batteries

Can you recycle a battery?

Reduce fire risk and save precious resources by recycling your batteries. Common household batteries include lithium-ion button batteries from watches, hearing aids, etc, as well as standard barrel-type batteries (AAs, AAAs and so on). You must recycle these household batteries at dedicated battery collection points.

How do you dispose of a battery?

To dispose of the batteries safely, cover the positive terminal of the battery with protective caps or masking tape when grouping used batteries for disposal. This will ensure the battery type is still identifiable at the recycling centre, while also protecting you from danger; do not wrap the entire battery so that it is unrecognisable.

Why is battery recycling important?

When it comes to disposing of batteries, due to hazardous materials, proper recycling is necessary to prevent hazardous waste and harm to the environment. At GP, we're committed to developing more sustainable sources of power by working towards zero waste in our battery manufacturing facilities.

How do I export battery waste to the UK?

ABEs must follow the Waste Shipment Regulations. Use the waste export control tool to find the regulatory controls for your battery waste's destination country. Follow the waste export and import guidance to move waste batteries or waste battery materials like lead plates in or out of the UK for treatment and recycling.

Can battery waste be collected?

Battery waste may be accepted for collection as part of your local authority's household kerbside collection scheme; however, this may not always be the case. We advise you to check by visiting your local authority's website first.

Can you put batteries in a waste bin?

You should never place batteries in your general household waste bins, because depending on what waste bin you put it in, results in different hazards. Placing them in plastic/glass bins for example, mean they go to a recycling centre. At the centre, the batteries will be handled by workers who handle and sort the waste.
