Does Windows 8 have a battery report?

However, Windows 8, 10 & 11 include the capability to create a battery report that will show information about the general health of the battery, recent usage, usage history, and other statistics. The Windows Battery Report will show the health of your laptop battery, how well it has been performing, and how much longer it may last.

What is a laptop battery report?

The Windows Battery Report will show the health of your laptop battery, how well it has been performing, and how much longer it may last. The battery report will display battery information going back to when Windows was first installed. The report will be created in an HTML file and can be opened with a browser.

Does Windows 11 have a battery report?

For this reason, Windows allows you to generate a battery report that can be used to ascertain your laptop's battery health to let you decide if you need to replace the battery. Although a battery report sounds useful, generating one is more complex than navigating to the Battery section of the Windows 11 Settings app.

How does a battery report work?

The report will be created in an HTML file and can be opened with a browser. At the top of the battery report, basic information about your computer and whether connected standby is supported (this is the S0 Low Power Idle sleep state, my computer does not have this) will be displayed followed by the battery's specifications.

How to generate a battery report on Windows 11 laptop?

Instead of using the conventional Settings app or the Control Panel, you will need to execute a simple command in Command Prompt to generate a battery report on your Windows 11 laptop. Here are the steps for the same: Step 1: Press the Windows + S keys and type Command Prompt.

How to read a battery report on Windows 10?

Here's how you can access your Windows laptop, followed by an explanation regarding how you can read it. Step 1: Press the Win + E keys on your keyboard to open File Explorer. Step 2: When a This PC File Explorer window appears on your screen, navigate to the location where you saved the battery report.
